

# FEATURED NEW INVESTIGATOR AWARD

New investigators are encouraged to submit their original research or review articles to *Translational Research*.

A Featured New Investigator (FNI) Award of \$1,500 is given annually to the best article published in the preceding year.

The Council of the Central Society of Clinical and Translational Research (CSCTR) reviews all FNI articles and selects a winner to present the article at the annual meeting of the CSCTR, held in Chicago in April. A travel stipend, in addition to the \$1,500 award, is provided to cover travel expenses.

## Eligibility Requirements

- New investigators must be the first or senior author on an article
- New investigators must be within 10 years of completing post-doctoral or fellowship training at the time of submission
- Priority is given to original research articles
